



- 1. Dormitory Traffic Flow Planning and Poster Production (Division of Student Housing Service)**
- 2. Meals (Office of Student Safety):**
 1. During the stay, the Office of Student Safety will pay meals in advance, and the payment will be made by the students living in dorms after the quarantine.
 2. The Office of Student Safety will send the meals to the shelf at the entrance of the controlled floor.
- 3. Garbage Disposal (Division of Student Housing Service):**
 1. Delivery of special garbage bags (provided by the Center for Environmental Protection and Occupational Safety and Health).
 2. On the garbage bag, mark with the words "for dorm care and quarantine only" and the date of release from isolation (the date shall be filled in by the students)
 3. After the care and quarantine periods expire, it will be placed for another 2 days and handled according to the original garbage and collection methods.
- 4. Health education (Health and Counseling Center):** provide related health education and health status tracking during the care/quarantine period.
- 5. Provide daily necessities (Division of Student Housing Service):**
 1. They will be placed on the shelf at the entrance of the controlled floor for students to take and use in the dormitory room.
 2. Fees are covered by student accommodation fees.
- 6.** Each dorm has a fixed time for bathing and washing, and students are requested to clean up and disinfect after use. The Division of Student Housing Service replenishes disinfection materials at any time, and the public areas are uniformly cleaned by the school once a week.
- 7.** Students shall maintain social distancing when washing; they can only leave the room when taking meals, washing, bathing, and using the toilet. If they encounter other people, they shall not talk to each other, and they shall wear masks all the time, except when washing or bathing.

Note 1: Overseas students who are living off-campus and are required to be quarantined or taken care of may apply to live in the isolation or home-care dorms at their own expense if they are eligible for an exception to stay on campus.

Note 2: The order of priority for those staying in student dorms is as follows: 1) Overseas students live off campus; 2) Overseas students live in campus; 3) Students from poor families (proof must be provided) : the parents have no means of transportation; 4) Those who have household registration in Hualien , Taitung and outlying islands.

Note 3: Definition of dorms for home-quarantine and home-care:
Dorms for home-quarantine are provided for close contacts who have rapid antigen tested negative.
Dorms for home-care are provided for confirmed-cases students and close contacts who have rapid antigen tested positive.

Note 4: After 7 days of home care, another 7 days of self-health management (7+7 days) shall be carried out. During this period, students may enter the school according to the regulations of "NCHU Risk Levels and Corresponding Measures".

Note 5: After 3 days of home-quarantine, 4 days of self-initiated epidemic prevention shall be performed. These students are not allowed to go to school, go out, or enter any public places. Those who have returned to their own homes for home-quarantine shall not go to school or return to their dorms within these 4 days of self-initiated epidemic prevention.

When home-care (7+7) ^{Note 4} or home-quarantine (3+4) ^{Note 5} period expires, those who pass the test may return to normal life and they shall continue keeping alert.
